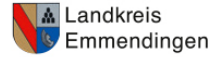

KeKs – facilitating communication, strengthening cooperation

KeKs offers the support provided by „Frühe Hilfen“ directly at the maternity hospital giving advice and support to young parents and families at the start to their family life.

How does it work?

A female member of staff will inform you on offers of support. In a conversation with her you will find out which offers of “Frühe Hilfen” might be suitable for you. Subsequent to that and if you give your consent, the staff member will make contact with the special services of “Frühe Hilfen”. At your wish, the staff member of “Frühe Hilfen” will visit you directly during your hospital stay or at home. You may also agree an appointment with the advice center.

KeKs offers assistance with:

- Questions on the development, the care and the nourishment of the baby
- Insecurities and stresses after delivery
- The procurance of further offers of assistance, e. g. with financial problems
- Difficult situations in life (e. g. separation, isolation)
- Questions on the interaction with public authorities (also by help of an interpreter)
- The procurance of practical help to provide relief in everyday life

We provide counselling:

- Free of charge
- On a voluntary basis
- On an anonymous basis by request
- On a confidential basis – we are subject to secrecy
